General Education Initiative Description

The Kansas Board of Regents (KBOR) (https://www.kansasregents.gov/academic_affairs/general-education/general-education-exceptions/) has approved the Systemwide General Education Framework. It is comprised of 34-35 credit hours organized in six discipline-based "buckets" and an institutionally designed bucket. A student who satisfies all seven buckets will complete the systemwide GE program.

Please note this framework applies to the completion of the Associate of Arts (AA) (<https://catalog.jccc.edu/archives/2025-26/degree/requirements/associate-arts/>), Associate of Fine Arts (AFA) (<https://catalog.jccc.edu/archives/2025-26/degree/requirements/associate-fine-arts/>), and Associate of Science (AS) (<https://catalog.jccc.edu/archives/2025-26/degree/requirements/associate-science/>) degrees only. Students that have not completed the General Education requirements for the AA, AFA, or AS, will have coursework reviewed on a course-by-course basis.

The Associate of Applied Science (AAS) (<https://catalog.jccc.edu/archives/2025-26/degree/requirements/associate-applied-science/>) degree and the Associate of General Studies (AGS) (<https://catalog.jccc.edu/archives/2025-26/degree/requirements/associate-general-studies/>) degree do not apply to the KBOR Systemwide General Education Framework. Please see your JCCC Counselor if you are pursuing the AAS or AGS degree.

Degree requirements at the four-year colleges are subject to change by those institutions.
