Enrollment is subject to the approval of the BNSF Railway training director and JCCC division administrator.

Upon successful completion of this program, you should have the ability to safely operate track welding equipment, perform basic and advanced welding operations, and complete specialized procedures as needed to perform the job of railway track welder.
