Program Description

The Associate of Arts (AA) (https://catalog.jccc.edu/degreerequirements/associate-arts/) degree is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the AA may select courses that satisfy both the AA degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the AA allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The AA degree requires completion of 60 credit hours. Meeting with a JCCC counselor (https://www.jccc.edu/student-resources/counseling/academic-counseling/) is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.

The Bachelor of Applied Science in Operations Management program is designed as a baccalaureate degree-completion program. This degree completion program will prepare students to enter careers such as supply chain management, production management, purchasing, project management, and other related fields.

This is a hybrid program, meaning all of Operations Management core classes can be completed 100% online while additional degree requirements may be online or in-person at the Edwards Campus. Contact your KU Edwards academic advisor for more information about classes.

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Admissions Requirements

Applicants are assured admission with 24+ transferable credit hours with a GPA of 2.5. Only transfer grades of "C-" or higher will count towards KU degree requirements. All grades count in the transferable GPA used for admission decisions. Apply at KU Admissions (https://admissions.ku.edu/) by selecting the Transfer application and selecting the Edwards Campus or the Jayhawk Global. International transfer students submit a KU application through International Admissions (http://world.ku.edu/).

• Submit an official transcript from each college you've attended.

Graduation Requirements

- The minimum total hours for graduation are 120.
- A maximum of 75 hours may be transferred to KU from community colleges. Students should be aware that 45 junior/senior credit hours are
 required for completion of the bachelor's degree; 30 of those hours must be at KU; and community college courses do not transfer as junior/
 senior hours.
- A minimum of a 2.0 KU GPA in junior/senior courses (300+) in the major.

- Students who transfer to KU, without completing Associate of Arts (AA) (https://catalog.jccc.edu/degreerequirements/associate-arts/), Associate of Fine Arts (AFA) (https://catalog.jccc.edu/degreerequirements/associate-fine-arts/) or Associate of Science (AS) (https://catalog.jccc.edu/degreerequirements/associate-science/) degree will have courses evaluated on a course-by-course basis toward meeting KU requirements.
