#### DESCRIPTION

Rockhurst University is a private Jesuit liberal arts university in Kansas City, Missouri, founded in 1910. With an enrollment around 3,000 students, it offers more than 70 undergraduate and graduate programs across fields like business, health sciences, and the liberal arts.

Rooted in Jesuit values, Rockhurst emphasizes learning, leadership, and service. Students engage in meaningful community outreach, service-learning, and have opportunities for mission trips both locally and abroad.

Small class sizes (averaging about 25 students) and a student-faculty ratio of roughly 14:1 help ensure personal attention from faculty. Located on a beautiful 55-acre campus in the heart of Kansas City, Rockhurst combines strong academic rigor with a vibrant campus life.

## TRANSFER ADMISSION PROCEDURES/QUALIFICATIONS:

### Application:

- Visit the online application (<https://catalog.jccc.edu/transfer-guides/rockhurst/rockhurst-transfer/www.rockhurst.edu/apply/>) to apply for admission.
- Official transcripts from all colleges/universities where applicant has enrolled.
- Official high school transcript (if applicant has completed less than 24 credit hours post-high school).
- The admissions committee will make the admission decision after reviewing the application and credentials.
- Reference letters are not needed.

### ACT/SAT Scores:

- Not required.

### Early Registration:

- Transfer students are eligible to register for their first term on the first day of registration (late March for Summer and Fall, and late October for Spring).

## TUITION/FEES/EXPENSES

### Undergraduate Tuition:

- \$22,833 (per semester, enrolled in 12-18 hours per semester)

### Fees:

- Approximately \$980 per year (Full-time)

### Room and Meals:

- Room rates starting at \$3,998 per semester.
- Meal plans starting at \$2,220 per semester.

### Books:

- Approximately \$800/yr.

### Estimated Additional Expenses:

- Enrollment Deposit \$200
- Orientation Fee transfer student \$50
- Matriculation Fee \$60
- Parking Pass \$270
- Health Insurance (if you are not already covered) \$2,930.

### Cost per Credit Hour:

- Under 12 hours or over 18 hours: \$7448 per credit hour

## FINANCIAL AID/SCHOLARSHIPS

### Application Deadline:

- Rolling Admissions but April 1st for fall and December 1st for spring is recommended.
- Rockhurst's priority FAFSA date for maximum aid potential is February 1.
- Rockhurst's Federal School Code is **002499**.

### Transfer Scholarships:

- Merit scholarships are awarded based on GPA:
  - 3.6 - 4.0: Distinguished Scholar - \$20,000/year
  - 3.0 - 3.59: Founder's Scholarship - \$16,000/year
  - 2.6 - 2.99: Endeavor Scholarship - \$12,000/year
- Phi Theta Kappa membership - \$24,000/year. Proof of membership required.
- Transfer Advantage Scholarship: \$500

## TRANSFER CREDIT/GRADING POLICIES

### Application of Credit:

- Associate of Arts Degree meets Block Transfer requirements (<https://www.rockhurst.edu/admissions/transfer/block-transfer-program/>). Students will need to take 3 additional courses to fulfill Rockhurst Core Requirements.
- Associate of Science Degree meets Block Transfer Requirements (<https://www.rockhurst.edu/admissions/transfer/block-transfer-program/>). Students will need to take an additional 4 courses to fulfill the Rockhurst Core Requirements.
- Transfer credit is evaluated on a course- by- course basis if a student does not have an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science.
- There is no Physical Education requirement.
- A maximum of 64 credit hours can be transferred from a community college

### GPA Required:

- A holistic review of applications will be conducted upon receipt of all requirements. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required to graduate from Rockhurst.

### Pass/Fail:

- Coursework with a grade of Pass, Credit, or Satisfactory will be accepted only with documented evidence that such grades are at least equivalent to a minimum "C-" grade.

### "D" Grades:

- Not accepted for General Education or Major requirements (unless as part of a block transfer).

### Time Limit on Credit:

- No time limit.

### Credit Given for:

- Military Experience upon review of the Office of the Registrar.

### CLEP Policy:

- General CLEP Examinations are not accepted. Subject Level Examinations will be reviewed by the Office of the Registrar.
