Transfer Admission Procedures/Qualifications

Application:

- Submit an application (<https://applywu.webster.edu/portal/apply>) is available online at or at the campus.
- \$50 nonrefundable application fee is required, payable on-line by credit card.
- An official transcript submitted directly from each college, university or other post-secondary institution attended showing all work attempted to date.

- Webster accepts electronic transcripts if sent as official through services such as Parchment, National Student Clearinghouse, or eScript-Safe, or if sent through a secure server directly from the institution. These should be sent to transcripts@webster.edu (<https://catalog.jccc.edu/transfer-guides/webster/webster-transfer-info/transcripts@webster.edu>) if an email address is requested. Email attachments are not considered official.
- Students may apply any time; Webster University – Kansas City’s terms begin in January, March, June, August, and October. We offer evening classes, online and, occasionally Saturday classes.
- Transfer students are welcome to visit the campus during regular business hours, Monday – Thursday 8:30 A.M. - 6 P.M., Fridays 8:30 A.M. – 12:00 P.M.

International Students:

- All non-U.S. citizens, other than permanent residents, should contact International Student Recruitment and Services at www.webster.edu/iris for information regarding requirements or Christy White, Recruitment Coordinator, at 816.926.4288.

Military Students

- Military applicants should consult both their Webster University representative and ESO prior to enrollment. Members of the U.S. Army must apply (<https://www.goarmy.com/benefits/while-you-serve/education-training.html>) for admission. Applications will then be directed to the Office of Admission for entry. All documents required for admission to the degree program will apply. Applicants with prior military experience must submit copies of their service records to be considered for transfer credits. For Air Force servicemen and women, transcripts from the Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) are acceptable. Transcripts from CCAF should be requested and sent to the Webster University Office of Admission. For all other branches of service, the Joint Services Transcript (JST (<https://www.military.com/education/timesaving-programs/the-joint-services-transcript.html>)) transcript should be requested and sent to the Office of Admission at transcripts@webster.edu (<https://catalog.jccc.edu/transfer-guides/webster/webster-transfer-info/transcripts@webster.edu>).

Transfer Qualifications:

- This is a degree completion program. Students who have earned an associate degree from JCCC may transfer up to 98 credit hours to Webster as a part of the complete associate degree. Students without an associate degree may transfer up to 64 credit hours.
- For RN's the minimum GPA acceptable by the Nursing Department is 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Courses with a grade of "A", "B", "C", or "D" will transfer as credit; however, courses with the grade of "D" will not count toward general education courses. In the BA - Management, one grade of "D" is acceptable toward core course requirements in the major.
- Courses must be numbered 100 level or above to transfer.
- ACT or SAT scores are not required for transfer students.
- Official evaluation is based on official transcripts from previous accredited institutions.

Tuition/Fees/Expenses

Tuition and Fees:

- RN-BSN online courses are \$360 per credit hour.
- Part-time undergraduate tuition courses are \$475 per credit hour.
- Undergraduate online courses are \$475 per credit hour (excluding military students).
- Undergraduate online courses are \$250 per credit hour for military students (Active Duty, Guard, and Reserve).
- Textbook costs vary, depending on the course.
- There is a \$100 graduation fee.

Financial Aid/Scholarship

Application Deadline:

- Students may apply for Financial Aid in the form of loans at any time of the year.
- For Pell grants (need-based) the preferred deadline is March 1. Other grants may be available if the student is a dependent.
- When filling out the FAFSA, Webster's code is #002521.
